### **UTC BOARD OF DIRECTORS INCREASES DIVIDEND 21 PERCENT**

HARTFORD, Conn., June 13, 2007 -- United Technologies Corp. (NYSE:UTX) Board of Directors today approved a 21 percent quarterly dividend increase to 32 cents per common share. The dividend is payable September 10, 2007, to shareowners of record at the close of business on August 17.

“UTC has nearly tripled its dividend in the past six years,” said Chairman and Chief Executive Officer George David. “The board’s action today reflects consistently strong cash flow and affirms our confidence in sustained earnings growth.”

UTC has paid cash dividends on its common stock for 71 consecutive years dating to 1936.
